Bible Camp for Children

Conduct a 5 day Bible Camp (Monday-Friday, June 2-6) for the children of Wisdom Community School who have met the required attendance criteria for the 2014 terms to that point. The camp will be conducted by the Living Well Camp Team in conjunction with some local volunteers. Approximately 200 children are expected to attend.

The camp will include:

- Bible lessons
- Music
- Arts and crafts projects
- Sports and games
- Lunch meal each day for all campers
- Camp t-shirt for each child

Campers will be divided into morning and afternoon groups.

Teacher Development

As the children attend Camp Wisdom, teachers will receive training in teaching skills and discipleship.

Buildings and Property

The Living Well construction team in conjunction with some local hired labor will complete the following projects:

- Paint interior and exterior of new classroom building
- Concrete sidewalks
- Paint exterior of both existing toilet latrine buildings
- Install more landscaping plants
- Misc building and grounds

Mwenye Community (around school)

On the Saturday following the Bible Camp (June 7), conduct the following:

- Afternoon – have the “closing ceremonies” for the campers and their parents/guardians
- Provide refreshments for the campers and guardians

Many team members raise all or most of their financial support through donations.
