CHILDREN OF WISDOM

- * Orphans: many have lost one or both parents, living with relatives or neighbors
- * Education: children would not be able to attend public school for lack of funds for school, fees, uniforms, books
- * Neighborhood: area is a slum of a slum
- * Family size: 4-8 children
- * Homes: no running water, electricity, or indoor kitchens/restrooms, dirt floors, minimal furniture
- * Guardians: many unemployed, poverty income, many are illiterate/educated
- * Health: no local healthcare, high HIV-AIDS rates in country, many children deal with coughs from indoor charcoal fires and dusty conditions

JOIN THE TEAM

COST: \$3,500* per person all inclusive
Costs include: Airfare, lodging, meals, ground transportation, and travel insurance. (Does not include immunizations.)

DEADLINES for 2016:

- **January 15** - Application due for new team members (have not been on a previous mission with LIVING WELL)
- **February 1** - \$1000 Deposit due
- **March 1** - \$1500 Payment due
- **April 1** - \$1000 Payment due

Many team members raise all or most of their financial support through donations. We can assist you with raising your support. All expenses and donations are fully tax-deductible.

MISSION is open to adults (or students who have graduated from high school) and high school students if accompanied by a parent.

Complete itinerary, cost information, and team member application form are available upon request. All team member will have three team meetings to train for the mission. New team members will have an additional orientation.
