I. Bible Camp for Children

Conduct a 5 day Bible Camp (Monday-Friday, June 3-7) for the children of Wisdom Community School who have met the required attendance criteria for the 2013 terms to that point. The camp would be conducted by the Living Well Camp Team in conjunction with some local volunteers. Approximately 150 children are expected to attend.

The camp would include:

- Discipleship lessons in small groups
- Music
- Arts and crafts projects
- Sports and games
- Lunch meal each day for all campers
- Camp t-shirt for each child

Campers will be divided into morning and afternoon groups.

II. Buildings and Property

The Living Well construction team in conjunction with some local hired labor will complete the following projects:

- Install ceilings in existing classroom building (framing, ceiling panels, trim, paint)
- Paint exterior of both existing toilet latrine buildings
- Repaint bottom portion of existing classroom building exterior with oil enamel
- Install metal flagpole, including concrete base
- Install French drain piping at perimeter of existing classroom building
- Install more landscaping plants in front of existing classroom building

III. Mwenye Community (around school)

On the Saturday following the Bible Camp (June 8), conduct the following:

- Late afternoon – have the “closing ceremonies” for the campers and their guardians
- Provide refreshments for the campers and guardians
- After dark – show the *Jesus Film* on the side of the building using a generator powered projector and sound system. All community residents invited to view film.
